Submissions Guidelines 2016

- **What is a review?** A review paper is an overview of the current published research on a given field. It is an opportunity for the author to summarize the research done so far, recommend a direction for future research, and present new ideas on how to approach the field from a different perspective.
- **Who can submit?** Any undergrad! Articles can be submitted under the headings of Life Sciences, Natural Sciences, Chemistry and Physics, but students need not be from these disciplines. We encourage everyone to get involved.
- **How do I choose a topic?** You can write on anything that interests you! The important thing is that once you choose a topic you follow up with researching the relevant published and peer-reviewed journal articles. Current work such as physics poster projects, chemistry broad curriculum presentations, schols preparation or final year projects can also provide prompts for research article ideas.
- **What is the selection process?** There is an editor assigned for each of the categories who will work alongside an academic advisor and a team of undergraduate and postgraduate students in selecting the best articles for publishing.
- **Can I adapt previously completed work?** Yes, provided it fits the submission guidelines set out on our [writing your review](#) section. The article would have to be submitted to the college before our print date and if any work is associated with a module it must be stated in the acknowledgements section. All articles will be put through a plagiarism checker that will verify the original authors and their sources.
- **Can I submit more than one article?** Unfortunately we can only allow one submission per student.

Specifics

- Word Count – 2500 words not including references, $\pm 10\%$
- Format- MS word (.doc or .docx) or LaTeX submissions are accepted
- Please draw out Chemical structures (ChemDraw can be downloaded for free and is a great resource for this)
- The selection process is entirely anonymous. Please do not include any indications of your identity in the document submission. Please fill out the cover form on trinityssr.com and attach this with your submission, this will allow us to identify your submission while keeping anonymity.
- Please use Vancouver Style Referencing
